If your project addresses the principles of sustainability and you want to achieve eco-friendliness, then a Chartered Architectural Technologist, MCIAT, qualified as a Chartered Environmentalist, CEnv, will be able to work with you on your project, to achieve a unique and environmentally friendly project that meets your needs for a sustainable world.

What is a Chartered Environmentalist, CEnv?

Chartered Environmentalists are Chartered Architectural Technologists, MCIAT, that have been assessed and qualified within the environmental sector. The qualification demonstrates a commitment to environmental best practice and a high degree of expertise within the sector.

Chartered Architectural Technologists provide architectural design services and solutions. They are specialists in the science of architecture, building design and construction and form the link between concept and construction. They negotiate the construction project and manage the process from conception through to completion.

Once qualified as a Chartered Environmentalist, Chartered Architectural Technologists are permitted to use the letters CEnv additionally to their designation MCIAT.



Why do I need a Chartered Environmentalist?

Increasing recognition of the environmental challenges that the world faces, means that the role of the Chartered Environmentalist is more important than ever.

Chartered Architectural Technologists as Chartered Environmentalists have proven knowledge, experience and commitment to the environment and sustainability.

The Chartered Environmentalist qualification is a recognised standard of excellence for Chartered Architectural Technologists who are environmental practitioners, take the lead in managing environmental assets and play an important part in the goal of a sustainable world.

How is a Chartered Architectural Technologist qualified as a Chartered Environmentalist?

The status of Chartered Environmentalist is a qualification awarded by the Society for the Environment (SocEnv) the leading and coordinating body in environmental matters and champion of a sustainable environment.

The Chartered Institute of Architectural Technologists (CIAT) is a Constituent Body member of the Society for the Environment to promote the advancement of the dissemination of knowledge and education in good environmental practice for the public benefit. As such it has been licensed to award the designation Chartered Environmentalist, CEnv, to its Chartered Members since 1 June 2008.

How do Chartered Architectural Technologists become Chartered Environmentalists?

To become a Chartered Environmentalist, Chartered Architectural Technologists must have a minimum of twelve points of knowledge and/or experience, demonstrate knowledge of, competence in and engagement with sustainable management of the environment and/or sustainability matters and agree to comply with the Society for the Environment's Code of Ethics and the CPD requirements of CIAT. NB. One year of relevant academic experience is two points and one year of relevant professional experience is one point.

Once Chartered status is achieved, retention will also require continued membership of CIAT. Chartered Environmentalists may transfer their registration to another licensed Constituent Body during their career.

Chartered Architectural Technologists must have their competence assessed by a professional review process and then successfully pass a Professional Review Interview (PRI) to become a Chartered Environmentalist. All assessment is undertaken by CIAT.


